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Community-Based Training and Coaching Programs to Adjust English Language Skills

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Abstrak

Bahasa Inggris merupakan salah satu keterampilan yang penting dalam era globalisasi. Namun, keterampilan berbahasa Inggris pada siswa MA DDI Banua Sendana masih rendah dibuktikan dengan hasil observasi awal yang dilakukan oleh pengabdi atau peneliti. Hasil belajar bahasa inggris di sekolah tersebut masih tergolong tidak memenuhi KKM atau standar Kriteria Ketuntasan Minimal (KKM). Oleh karena itu, program pengabdian masyarakat ini dilakukan dengan tujuan meningkatkan keterampilan berbahasa Inggris pada siswa MA DDI Banua Sendana melalui program pelatihan dan pembinaan berbasis komunitas. Metode yang digunakan dalam program ini adalah pelatihan dan pembinaan berbasis komunitas selama 1 bulan kepada siswa dan guru-guru bahasa Inggris yang terlibat. Pelatihan dan pembinaan berfokus pada pengenalan kosakata, tata bahasa, serta kecakapan berbicara dan menulis dalam bahasa Inggris. Selain itu, program ini juga melibatkan mahasiswa bahasa Inggris sebagai fasilitator pelatihan dan pembinaan. Hasil dari program ini menunjukkan peningkatan yang signifikan pada keterampilan berbahasa Inggris siswa MA DDI Banua Sendana. Dalam tes yang dilakukan setelah program berakhir, terdapat peningkatan rata-rata nilai sebesar 45% pada kemampuan berbicara, menulis, dan memahami kosakata bahasa Inggris. Selain itu, program ini juga berhasil meningkatkan motivasi dan minat siswa dalam belajar bahasa Inggris. Kesimpulan dari program pengabdian masyarakat ini adalah bahwa pelatihan dan pembinaan berbahasa Inggris berbasis komunitas dapat menjadi solusi dalam meningkatkan keterampilan berbahasa Inggris pada siswa sekolah dasar di daerah pedesaan. Diharapkan program ini dapat terus dikembangkan dan diadopsi oleh lembaga-lembaga pendidikan lainnya untuk memberikan manfaat yang lebih besar bagi masyarakat di daerah pedesaan.

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Abstract

English is one of the essential skills in the era of globalization. However, English language skills in MA DDI Banua Sendana students still need to improve, as evidenced by the results of preliminary observations made by servants or researchers. English learning outcomes at the school still need to meet the KKM or Minimum Completeness Criteria (KKM) standards. Therefore, this community service program was carried out through a community-based training and coaching program to improve English language skills in MA DDI Banua Sendana students. The method used in this program is community-based training and coaching for one month for the students and English teachers involved. The training and coaching focused on introducing vocabulary, grammar, and speaking and writing skills in English. In addition, the program also involved English language students as training and coaching facilitators. The program results showed a significant improvement in the English language skills of MA DDI Banua Sendana students. In a test conducted after the program ended, there was a 30% increase in the average score on speaking, writing, and understanding English vocabulary. In addition, the program also succeeded in increasing students' motivation and interest in learning English. This community service program concludes that community-based English language training and coaching can be a solution in improving English language skills in primary school students in rural areas. This program can continue to be developed and adopted by other educational institutions to provide more significant benefits to communities in rural areas.

METHOD

a. Observation

Observations were made by making visits to DDI schools and conducting interviews with English teachers and parents. In the observation stage, the community service team collects information related to the English skills of elementary school students, including obstacles faced by students in learning English. From the observations, it was found that students' English skills were still relatively low. Students are poorly trained in speaking, writing, and understanding English vocabulary. In addition, English teachers in some schools are also less skilled and lack adequate resources to carry out learning activities. Based on these findings, the community service team then designed an English-language training and coaching program for English students and teachers. This program is designed to improve students' English language skills and improve the competence of English teachers through community-based training and coaching. b. Interview
